



Consent to Service

Deposits

Deposits will be equal to two months average billing on previous local and long distance services. Deposits are held for a minimum of one year and will accrue interest at the rate prescribed by the company. In the absence of prior service, the deposit will be based on estimated usage. If usage exceeds estimate of prior average, an additional deposit equal to two times the average usage will be required. Any Balance carried over to the next billing cycle will be assessed a 1.5% late charge.

Subscriber Application and Consent for Service

By submitting this information the user hereby applies to Canby Telecom (CT) for telephone service to be provided to the applicant in accordance with its bylaws, rate schedules, and regulations.

"Permission is hereby granted to Canby Telcom to authorize its employee(s) to enter into or upon my premises during normal working hours for the purpose of making initial telephone connections, subsequent changes or for necessary maintenance and repairs. The undersigned further agrees to execute any easement or right of way contract on a form to be furnished by CT. As a member of CT, I hereby consent to the credit to my patronage dividend account of any overpayment of communications excise tax applied for by the secretary of CT on my behalf and refunded by the Internal Revenue Service. This consent applies as long as I am a member of Canby Telecom."

I promise and agree to pay promptly, on billing, all charges for service and if not paid, I promise and agree to pay the collection costs and reasonable attorney's fees to be fixed by the trial court if suit action is filed thereon and such further sum as may be fixed by the appellate court if an appeal is taken from any decision of the trial court.
